

## **CJACC Indoor Church Re-opening Policies and Guidelines**

We are pleased to share that with LA County's progression to the Red Tier, CJACC is now allowed to conduct indoor services with a maximum number of total individuals in the church being 25% of occupancy. The following indoor church guidelines have been implemented to help mitigate risk and keep staff and attendees healthy and safe. Those who are vulnerable should not attend in-person and are encouraged to continue to worship with us via Zoom. Please keep in mind that many of these measures are temporary and remain subject to change as we respond to the continuous developments of COVID-19.

### **Temperature checks and health screening for all staff and attendees:**

- All are expected to monitor their symptoms prior to arrival.
- Temperature checks and health screening will be required upon arrival.
- Those exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms or a temperature of 100.4° or higher will be asked to leave immediately.

### **Hygiene:**

- Restroom access will be limited to single-use occupancy.
- Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized at a minimum of once per hour while congregants are on the premises.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed throughout.

### **Masks/Face coverings:**

- Masks/face coverings must be worn at all times for all ages 2 and older.
- Masks with one-way valves are not permitted.
- Disposable masks will be provided if necessary.

### **Social distancing:**

- Social distancing will be maintained at all times. Shaking hands and hugging will be prohibited.
- Reservations will be required by 9pm on Friday to help manage occupancy.
- Seating assignments will allow for a minimum of six feet around each family unit.
- Floor markings will provide reminders and indicate appropriate distance and one-way traffic.
- The mother's room may be used for parents with infants and will be limited to single-family occupancy.

### **Main Service:**

- All doors will be open to allow for outside air circulation.
- Singing will be prohibited.
- Parent/guardians will be required to supervise their children at all times.
- Sabbath School rooms and the Social Hall will be off limits.
- Everyone will be asked to leave immediately after service. Deacons will dismiss rows to allow enough time for attendees to exit while practicing strict social distancing.
- To go snack bags will be available.

### **Cancelled until further notice:**

- Children's Church.
- Potluck.
- Fellowship before and after service.

### **Potential COVID-19 Case or Exposure:**

- If an attendee tests positive for COVID-19 or finds out having known exposure to confirmed COVID-19 cases, s/he shall report to the CJACC Risk Management Officer promptly (jstewart8664@gmail.com), and CJACC will notify others who were in attendance immediately.
- Contact tracing: A photo will be taken of the congregation and contact information will be collected during the registration process.
